DEVOTION

Can you see the wind? How do you know if the wind is blowing? What would you tell someone that said they don't believe in the wind because they can't see it? How do you know the wind is real?

Just like the wind, we aren't able to see God either. Name some ways that you know God is real even though we can't see Him....think about God's creation: landscape, sunsets, the human body, the Bible etc.

Younger Children: Read Romans 1:20 and discuss what it means. Take a walk outside and look at all of God's creation. Touch the grass, dirt and plants. Look at the sky, mountains, sunset.

Older Children: Read Genesis 1:1-2:23. Make a list of all the things God created, and on what day He created them. Take a walk outside and admire the perfect creation of our great God. Think about the size of the world and universe, the complexity of the human body, etc. Now think about the fact that God created all of it in 7 days without flaw. Pretty amazing, right?

Don't forget to spend some time in prayer as a family.

ACTIVITY

Make popcorn the old-fashioned way in a pot on the stove. Add chocolate chips, M&M's, nuts, sprinkles, etc. for a different spin on an old favorite.

Go to a hallway or small area in your house. String crepe paper across the area in all different directions. Depending on the age of your kids you can make this more/less difficult. Pretend the crepe paper is a lazer maze. Try to get from one side to the other without touching the lazars.
