CENTERING YOUR FAMILY TIME AROUND THE FIREPLACE OF GOD'S WORD

WHAT YOU NEED:

- * Root Beer
- * Ice cream
- * 12 eggs
- * Styrofoam cups
- * Rubber bands
- * Paper towels
- * Tallest ladder you have

DEVOTION

When you think about feet what is the first word that comes to mind? Sweaty, stinky, dirty? We are blessed to have good shoes, but not all people in the world have shoes to wear or water to wash their feet with.

Read John 13:1-17 and Romans 10:15

The Bible says that people who take the good news about Jesus to others have beautiful feet. It doesn't matter what their feet smell or look like, the feet of people preaching the good news about Jesus are beautiful.

What is a missionary? Do you know any missionaries that live here? Are you a missionary?

You can be a missionary, and God wants you to be His missionary. Maybe you have a friend at school that is curious about the Bible, or a cousin that doesn't know about God. How can you teach them that Jesus loves them and died for their sins?

Pray for specific people that need to meet Jesus. Pray for courage to tell the wonderful news that you already know! Make a plan....how will your family be missionaries in the Treasure Valley?

ACTIVITY

Make root beer floats, then:

This activity can be completed in teams or as individuals. Give each team/individual one egg & two Styrofoam cups. Tell them their egg will be dropped from a high distance and they must protect it within the cup. They may use rubber bands, paper towels, or other household items to help protect their egg, but the cups must be the outermost layer. If you want, put a time restriction on this part to make it more challenging.

Bring everyone together and drop the eggs from a high spot (ie. top of a ladder, off a balcony, off the roof). See who protected their egg the best.
